Notes

The Committee is responsible for fulfilling the Organisation's aims and general administration. The Committee can only be drawn from full members who attend Instructor training weekends.

The Committee must have a minimum of three principal officers: Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer; and other officers, who must be elected at the AGM or an EGM, following nomination by at least two full members. One member of the Committee must be a founder member. At least one third of the Committee must stand for re-election at each AGM and no officer shall serve more than three years without seeking re election. Simple majority at the AGM or EGM shall agree the office of Chairperson; other offices shall be nominated by the Chairperson and agreed by the Committee at the first meeting after any election.

Please Note: Committee officials have a responsibility to perform their duties in a satisfactory manner and to attend both days of the Instructor training weekends. Any elected officers will be asked to resign their post should they prove unable to meet either of these basic requirements.
